What is the role of historical associations like CFHA in this digital landscape? This lecture explores changes to the field in the past twenty years and examines opportunities for CFHA to play a significant role in making Canadian Quaker history part of the larger global map of Quaker history."

Robynne Rogers-Healey is professor of history as well as codirector of the Gender Studies Institute at Trinity Western University in Langley, British Columbia. She is currently convenor of the Conference of Quaker Historians and Archivists. Her publications include From Quaker to Upper Canada: Faith and Community among Yonge Street Friends, 1801-1850 (McGill-Queen's University Press, 2006) and a number of articles on Quakers and Quakerism. Her research interests include gender and Quakerism, the transatlantic world in the 18th and 19th centuries, the 20th-century peace testimony, and Canadian Quakerism. She has also served on the Canadian Friends Historical Association Executive for some years as editor of the journal.
